Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

As a parent or guardian of a Player participating in Stella Rossa Football Club, you play an essential role in supporting a positive, respectful, and development-focused environment. By joining the Club, you agree to uphold the standards outlined in this Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct.

1. Respect for Coaches and Staff

- Parents must treat all coaches, team personnel, and Club staff with respect.
- Coaching from the sidelines, contradicting the coach's instructions, or interfering with training or games is not permitted.
- Concerns should be addressed privately and respectfully following the Club's communication procedures.

2. Respect for Players

- Parents must support and encourage all players, not only their own child.
- Negative comments, criticism, or undermining behaviors toward any child are prohibited.

3. Respect for Opponents and Officials

- Parents must demonstrate sportsmanship at all times.
- Confronting referees or reacting aggressively toward opposing teams, parents, or spectators is strictly prohibited.
- Verbal abuse, intimidation, or harassment of officials is grounds for disciplinary action.

4. Sideline Behavior

- Parents must maintain a positive, calm, and encouraging presence during training and games.
- Yelling at players, coaches, or officials during matches is not allowed.
- Parents must follow all facility rules and must not enter the field or bench areas unless authorized.

5. Communication and Conduct

- Parents must communicate respectfully and constructively with coaches and Club staff.
- Threatening, hostile, harassing, or inappropriate communication - whether in person, online, or via messaging - is not tolerated.
- Parents agree not to engage in gossip, public criticism of the Club, or actions that create unnecessary conflict.

6. Social Media and Public Conduct

- Parents must behave responsibly on social media.
- Posting content that is harmful, discriminatory, inflammatory, or damaging to the Club, its staff, or its players is prohibited.
- Parents agree not to post photos or videos of other players without permission.

7. Support for the Player's Development

- Parents must encourage effort, learning, discipline, and commitment.
- Parents agree to respect the developmental approach and playing time philosophy established by the Club.



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8. Attendance and Logistics

- Parents must ensure the Player arrives on time, properly equipped, and prepared for practices and games.
- Parents agree to communicate absences promptly and clearly.

9. Compliance With Club Policies

- Parents must follow all Club rules and policies communicated through the website, handbooks, meetings, or official channels.
- Parents must ensure the Player also complies with all Club expectations.

Disciplinary Action

Violation of the Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary measures, including but not limited to:

- Verbal or written warnings
- Removal from training or game sidelines
- Required meetings with Club staff
- Temporary or indefinite suspension from attending Club activities
- Restriction from communication with coaches except through designated channels
- Suspension or dismissal of the Player from the Club when behavior prevents a safe and respectful environment

The Club reserves the right to restrict, suspend, or remove a Parent/Guardian or Player at its sole discretion if conduct is harmful, disruptive, unsafe, or in violation of Club standards or policies.
